ACT 1

CANNOLI

And Bunny reaches for the clouds!

COLESLAW

What shape are the clouds?

Coleslaw giggles, occasionally jumping to try and reach the plush.

INT. DAD'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

Meanwhile, WINSTON, the girls' dad and a ground squirrel, is seen typing at a COMPUTER, humming along to lo-fi music playing in the background, until-

The girls burst open the door!

WINSTON

AH!

Cannoli climbs over her dad's chair, then her dad, to get the high ground. Coleslaw <claps>

CANNOLI

They're daddy shaped!

Winston catches Cannoli and moves her to his lap.

WINSTON

Cannoli, Coleslaw, I've gotta get some work done.

COLESTAW

But daddy, mommy's gonna be here soon!

WINSTON

Oh, yeah? How soon?

Coleslaw stares down at the ANALOG CLOCK on the wall, but can't read it.

COLESLAW

(confidently)

4 am!

WINSTON

Hmmm, I don't think so.

CANNOLI

But I think so!

WINSTON

Alright, if I'm done with this boring work before your mom comes here to pick you up in-

Winston checks his WATCH.

WINSTON (CONT'D)

-13 minutes, then I can play with you, deal?

COLESLAW

Then what are we supposed to do until then?

Winston looks around, unsuccessfully.

WINSTON

(under his breath)
It's only half an hour.

CANNOLI

What?

WINSTON

Oh! New season of Zaney Toons just came out, why don't you two check that out on the TV downstairs?

Winston pulls a LINT ROLLER from his desk DRAWER and rolls himself down.

COLESLAW

Okay!

CANNOLI

C'mon, Coleslaw!

The girls run out of the room. Just after, Winston's PHONE begins to <ring>. He answers it.

WINSTON

Late?

A small beat for comedic effect. Winston continues using the lint roller beyond his clothes and down his tail.

WINSTON (CONT'D)

Gale, that doesn't help me. How late are you gonna be?

CUT TO:

EXT. BUSY STREET - CONTINUOUS

GALE, the girls' mom and a flying squirrel, is stuck in traffic. The camera zooms out to show just how many other cars surround her.

CAT.F

I don't know, Winston. I'm stuck in traffic.

INT. DAD'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

WINSTON

I told you not to leave during rush hour. The girls can't wait much longer to see you again.

CUT TO:

INT. DAD'S LIVING ROOM - A FEW MINUTES LATER

Cannoli and Coleslaw sit in front of the TV, while ZANEY TUNES, an obvious Looney Tunes parody, plays on the screen. The plush Bunny sits in Coleslaw's lap.

Coleslaw gets up from the COUCH and sits on the COFFEE TABLE to get a closer look at the TELEVISION screen. Cannoli follows, bringing Bunny with her.

On screen, a rabbit character is seen being launched from a cannon, then flying through the air through cloud puffs and over mountains.

CANNOLI

This is a little scary...

COLESLAW

Scary? This is the most awesome thing ever!

Cannoli uses Bunny to cover her eyes.

CANNOLI I don't think dad knows how violence this show really is.

Coleslaw takes Bunny from Cannoli's hands.

END OF ACT 1

ACT 2

EXT. BUSY STREET - CONTINUOUS

GALE

Hang on, traffic's finally clearing up! I'll call you back.

WINSTON

But-

Gale hangs up the phone. <Death metal> music starts playing from her car and there is a collective <groan> from the rest of the cars before they start moving again.

CUT TO:

INT. DAD'S LIVING ROOM - CONTINUOUS

Coleslaw runs around the couch with Bunny. Cannoli struggles to keep up.

CANNOLI

Hey! Bunny's mine! I didn't say you could play with him!

COLELSAW

Did you see Hugs Bunny do that flip? He was all like-

Coleslaw makes <zooming> noises with her mouth, then an "exploding" one when she directs Bunny to the floor.

COLESLAW

Oh no, bunnies don't have wings!

Cannoli tries to reach Bunny, but Coleslaw's not giving her an opening, and keeps running away with Bunny.

CANNOLI

He doesn't need wings to fly! He has movie magic!

CUT TO:

EXT. BACK ROAD

Gale is stuck behind a very slow car. She looks around, but can't pass the car because it's a one way road. She <honks> a few times, but the driver doesn't seem to hear.

GALE

C'mon grandma, move it!

The car in front of Gale slowly rolls down its window. A wrinkly arm shakes its way out, then shakes its fist.

OLD PERSON

That's grandpa to you!

Gale lets out a deep sigh.

CUT TO:

INT. DAD'S LIVING ROOM - CONTINUOUS

In front of the couch, Cannoli and Coleslaw stand up to each other in a scene straight out of a western movie. Coleslaw tightens her grip around Bunny. Cannoli stares her down. The camera briefly cuts to a wide shot to show what's actually happening, outside of the girls' imaginations.

CANNOTIT

I'm not gonna ask again. Bunny belongs to me.

COLESLAW

Well maybe Bunny wants a turn with me! Have you ever asked him?

Cannoli can't think of a response, so grunts and sulks. Coleslaw keeps playing with Bunny, zooming him around the room as her sister looks on, disapprovingly.

Soon, Coleslaw accidentally loses her grip and chucks Bunny across the room.

Cannoli rushes to Bunny's aid, and sees that his LEFT EAR has been torn off. Tears start to form in her eyes, and she opens her mouth, ready to-

CUT TO:

INT. DAD'S OFFICE - CONTINUOUS

Winston hears a <scream> and starts to leave his desk.

WINSTON

Crying? Who's crying?

INT. DAD'S LIVING ROOM - ABOUT 30 SECONDS LATER

Winston comes downstairs to see Cannoli crying over Bunny, and Coleslaw pouting in the corner of the room. He is clearly very overwhelmed.

WINSTON

What happened? I left you two alone for not even 20 minutes!

Cannoli comes crying to her dad.

CANNOLI

Daddy! Coleslaw hurt Bunny! Just look!

COLESLAW

That's what you get for hogging him!

CANNOLI

He's not a hog! He's a bunny, you
dummy!

Coleslaw rises from his slump and trudges over to her dad, who separates the two.

WINSTON

Hey now, it's mean to call people dummies!

END OF ACT 2

ACT 3

EXT. DAD'S HOUSE - ABOUT A MINUTE LATER

Gale parks her car and makes her way to the front door, <whistling>. She has a PIZZA BOX in hand and locks her car behind her with her KEYS.

INT. DAD'S LIVING ROOM - CONTINUOUS

Gale closes the door behind her.

GALE

Sorry it took so long, I went to get some-

She sees Winston standing between the girls with a hand on each of their heads to hold them apart, with Bunny tucked into his SHIRT, too high for them to reach.

Gale takes in her surroundings, puts the pizza on the counter, squats to get on the same level as the kids, and then-

GALE (CONT'D)

Hey, hey. What's going on? Give your mom a status update.

COLESLAW

I hurt Cannoli's bunny friend.

Coleslaw guiltily tugs on her own arm.

GALE

Oh no! Let me see him, doc.

Cannoli sniffs and hands Bunny to Gale, who takes a good look at him.

COLESLAW

Can you fix him?

Cannoli holds onto her tail in front of her.

CANNOLI

I don't want a new Bunny. I like this one.

CAT.E

Hey now. Bunny's not going anywhere.

Gale wipes away Cannoli's tears.

COLESLAW

I'm sorry, Cannoli. I really like Bunny too. But you never share him.

Gale looks at Coleslaw, then back at Cannoli.

GALE

Cannoli, is this true?

Cannoli clutches onto Bunny.

CANNOLI

It's just that— the world is bigger than it was before. I don't know what to do.

GALE

I know, it's scary sometimes. But that just means there's more pizza right?

Cannoli raises an eyebrow at Gale.

CANNOLI

What kind of pizza?

GALE

The kind with pine nuts. Your favorite.

Winston chuckles.

WINSTON

Takes after her mother.

COLESLAW

Does this mean I can get my own bunny too?

Gale looks over at Winston.

GALE

Yes. But it also means that even if you don't always get along, you still gotta be there for each other.

END OF ACT 3

TAG

INT. DAD'S KITCHEN

Gale sews up the plushie while Cannoli, eating a SLICE OF PIZZA, watches and slowly leans closer, almost dropping some MARINARA SAUCE onto the plushie, but Gale manages to dodge it away.

Meanwhile Coleslaw sits with her dad at the table, trying to eat a pizza slice thats too big for her to hold. Winston laughs before helping her hold it.

There is no dialogue, only peaceful, cheery music.
